- **Relevance of Content:** Does the content contain keywords identical to a user's search query? Regardless, an algorithm must determine if a page includes other relevant content beyond the keywords. Aggregated interaction data is assessed for relevance.
- **Quality of Content:** How helpful is the content? Does it demonstrate expertise? Can it show authoritativeness? How trustworthy is it? Do other prominent websites link or refer to it? These questions address whether the content provides genuine quality.
- **Usability of Content:** Content a user determines is easier to access may perform better in a search engine result. For instance, page experience considerations (such as the content's mobile friendliness and load speed) could impact website rankings.
- **Context & Settings:** Accuracy matters. A user's location, search history, and search settings may affect relevance at that moment. Consequently, high-quality and relevant content should surface in a query based on the user's interests and preferences.
